Further discussion centred on: How to capture the breadth of the committee's objective issues related to general Arts & Sciences issues as well as <i>Indigenous knowledge</i>, <i>Ianguage and experience</i>. The committee's scope should go beyond student mobility and support student success. A variety of suggestions were put forward rewording the objective Statements.
