# ACAT Student Mobility Reports: Student Yearly Enrolment Tracking

- ❖ The ACAT's Student Mobility Reports contain information regarding student enrolment flow and tracking for public post-secondary institutions and the six sectors in Alberta.
- ❖ These reports use Learner and Enrolment Reporting System (LERS) system data, which has been signed off by public post-secondary institutions, supporting easy access to existing data. **LERS system data includes data regarding all approved programs reported in LERS by publicly funded post-secondary institutions in Alberta's six sectors.**

# ACAT Student Mobility Reports: Student Yearly Enrolment Tracking

- ❖ The mobility reports are:
  - Institution and Sector Student Enrolment Flow reports, which provide student enrolment flows into, within, and out of Alberta's public post-secondary institutions and six sectors for a given academic year. These reports target the most recent, complete LERS system data set available.
  - A Student Yearly Enrolment Track by Post-Secondary Institution report, which provides tracking of student enrolment in public post-secondary institutions by academic year. This report looks back six years from the most current, valid LERS data available for a student cohort.
- ❖ Report updates will occur on a yearly basis as new LERS data is available and will maintain consistent templates.

## Student Yearly Enrolment Track By Post-Secondary Institutions

The Student Yearly Enrolment Track table identifies where were the number of students in an institution (cohort size) who had valid enrolment records (full time/part time) in LERS for the cohort year and five years prior by institution.

## Interpreting the Table:

- This report reflects tracking of student enrolment records at an institution (e.g., U. of L.) for a specific student cohort (e.g., 2011/12), identified by the highlighted section. All the data in the columns for the preceding academic years (e.g., 2006-2011) reflect where students were enrolled prior to the U. of L. for the highlighted cohort year.
- 2011/12 data in the last column reflect enrolment in the U. of L. in the highlighted cohort year (e.g., 9,340 students), as well as additional 2011/12 enrolment records for these same students at other institutions.

## Interpreting the Table:

- Of the 9,340 students at U. of L. in 2011-12, 2,433 were enrolled at the U. of L. in 2008-09.
- Of the 9,340 students at the U. of L. in 2011-12, 64 of these students were enrolled at Red Deer College in 2007-08.
- Of the 9,340 students at the U. of L. in 2011-12, 213 of these students were also enrolled at Lethbridge College.
