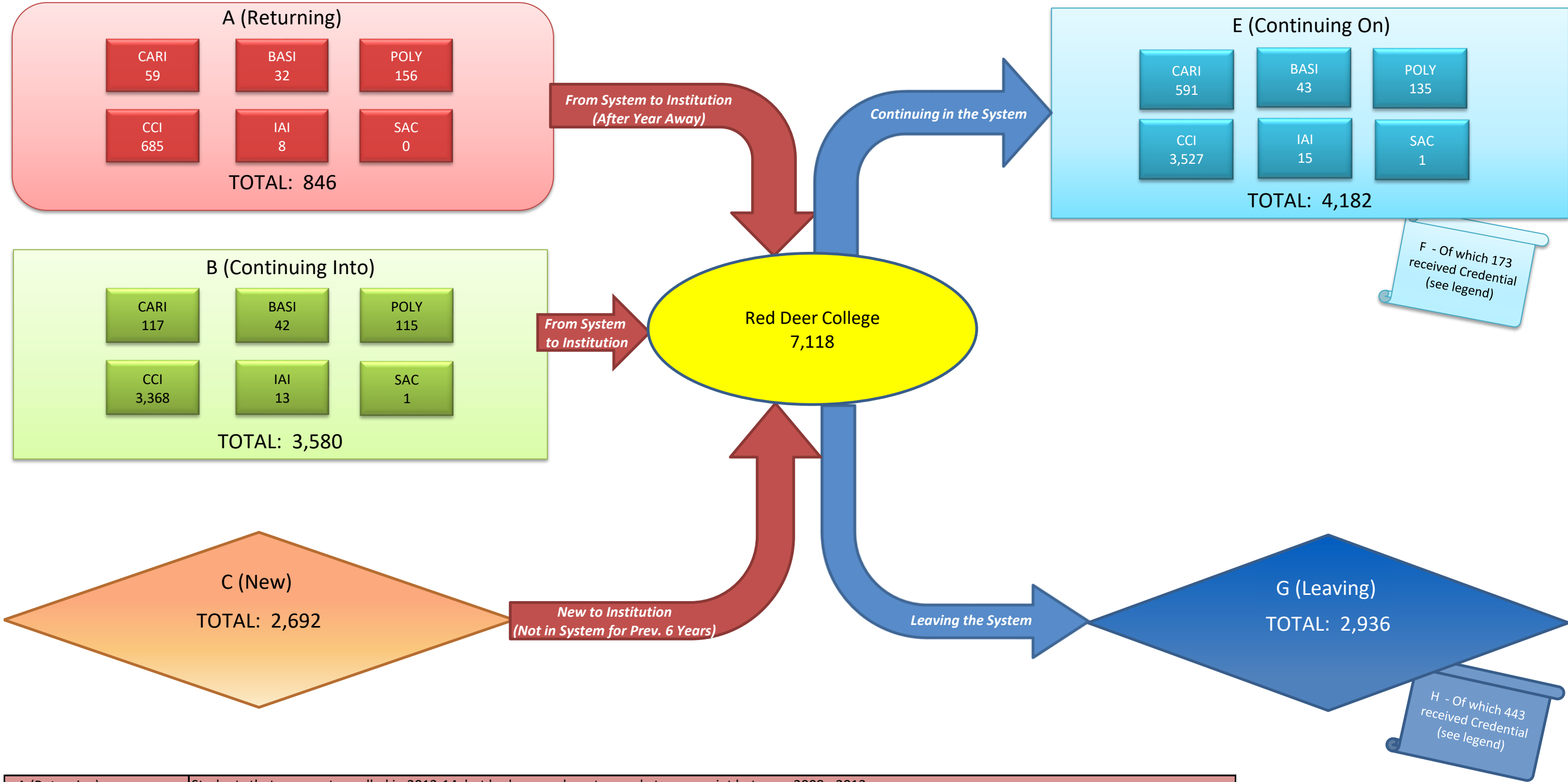


Institution Student Enrolment Flow

E (Continuing On)	Students enrolled in an institution for the following year (2015-2016)
F	Students enrolled in an institution for the following year (2015-2016), and received a credential from Red Deer College in 2014-2015
G (Leaving)	Students NOT enrolled at an institution in the following year (2015-2016)
H	Students NOT enrolled in an institution for the following year (2015-2016), but received a credential from Red Deer College in 2014-2015
