2 Objectives and Accountability

The Alberta Council on Admissions and Transfer (ACAT) was created under section 7 of the Government Organization Act to provide leadership and direction, as a cornerstone of Campus Alberta, in the improvement of educational opportunities for Alberta students through interinstitutional transfer. ACAT is an advisory agency accountable to the Minister of Advanced Education and Technology (Minister) and is responsible for providing advice and guidance regarding post-secondary admission and transfer practices. The council shall report, annually, on its activities to the Minister.

The objectives and responsibilities, accountability obligations and recruitment processes of ACAT are further described in its Mandate and Roles document.

3 Terms

- (a) A person appointed as a member of the council
 - (i) holds office for a term not exceeding 3 years but may be reappointed for further terms not exceeding 3 years so long as the reappointment would not result in the person serving as a member for more than 9 consecutive years;
 - (ii) continues to hold office after the expiry of the member's term until the person is reappointed, the person's successor is appointed or a period of 3 months has elapsed, whichever occurs first.
- (b) When there is a break in service of less than 2 years, only the periods of time before and after the break are included in determining the number of consecutive years under subsection (a).
- 4 Remuneration and Expenses
- (a) The chair and members of the council are entitled to be paid remuneration in accordance with Schedule 1, Part A of the Committee Remuneration Order, as amended from time to time;
- (b) The chair and members of the council are entitled to be paid travelling and living expenses in accordance with the Subsistence and Travel Allowance Regulation as though they were employees of the government.
