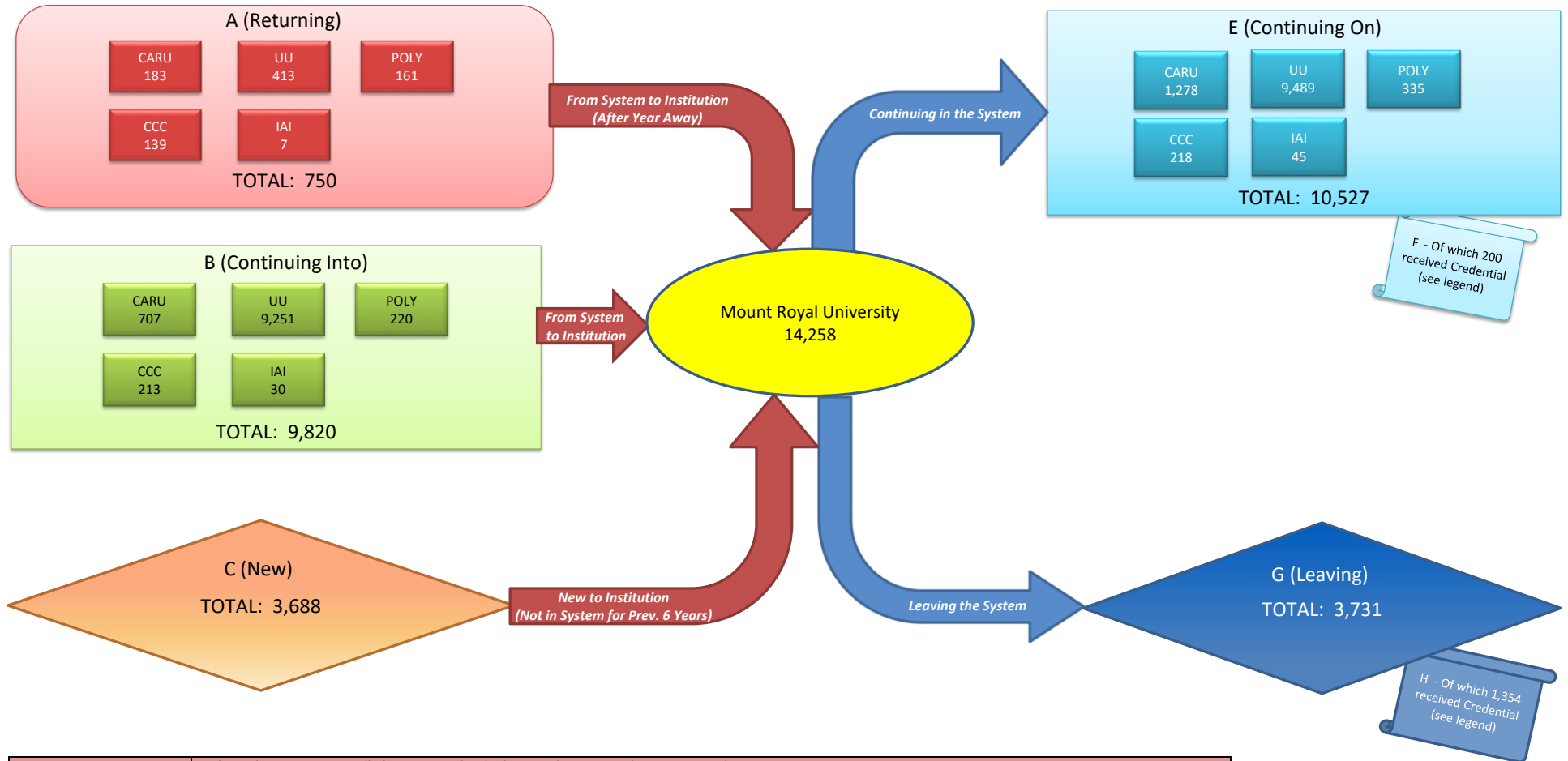


## Institution Student Enrolment Flow
