B. Review of Saskatchewan & Alberta 30 level courses

LPS data, member institution admission requirements, and Saskatchewan Ministry of Education courses were reviewed.

- Computer Science 30, English Language Arts 30, Indigenous Studies 30, Religious Studies 35, Science 30, and Social Studies 30 are still to be reviewed.
