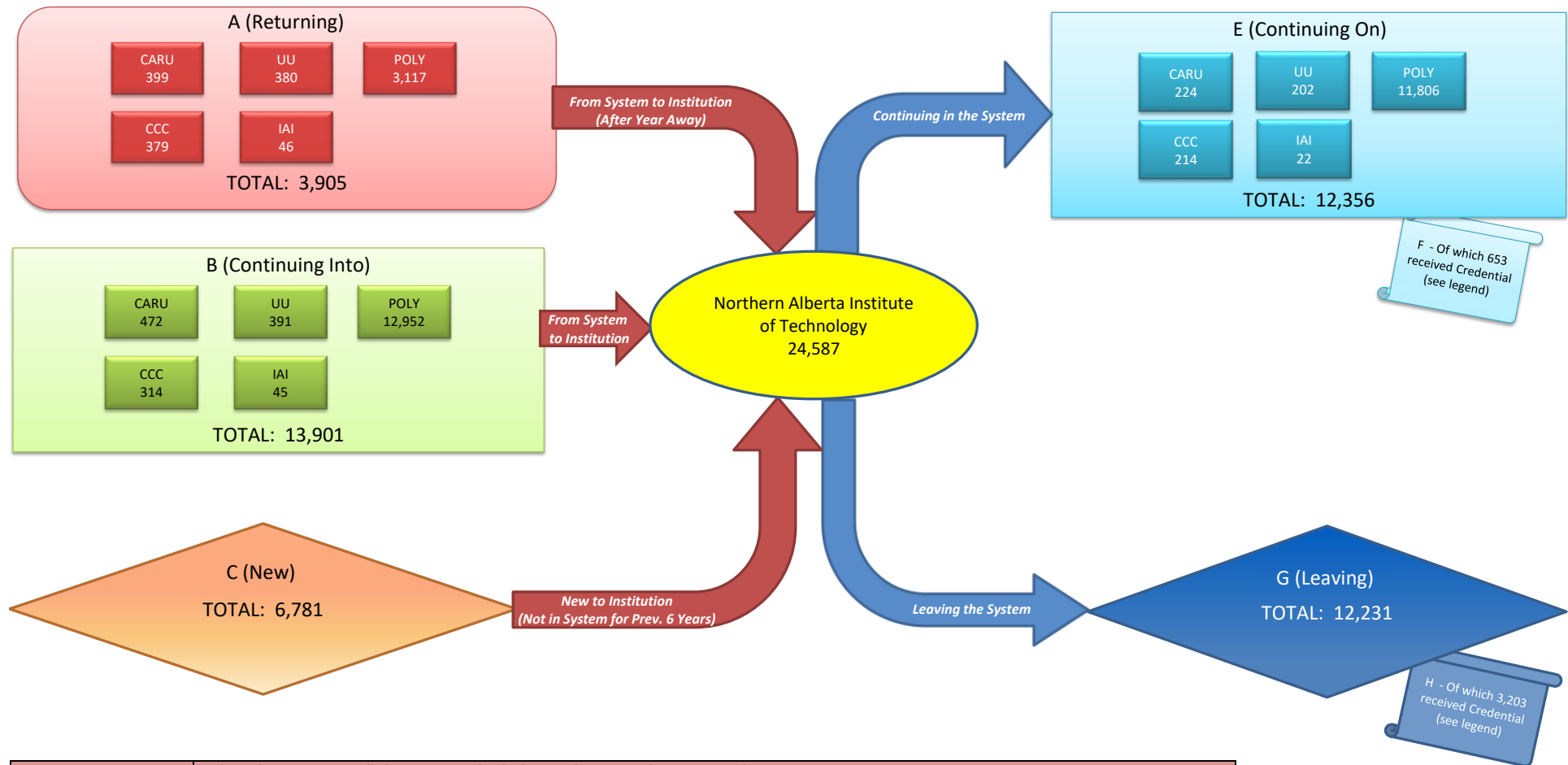


# Institution Student Enrolment Flow

| H                   | Students NOT enrolled in an institution for the following year (2019-2020), but received a credential from Northern Alberta Institute of Technology in 2018-2019 |
