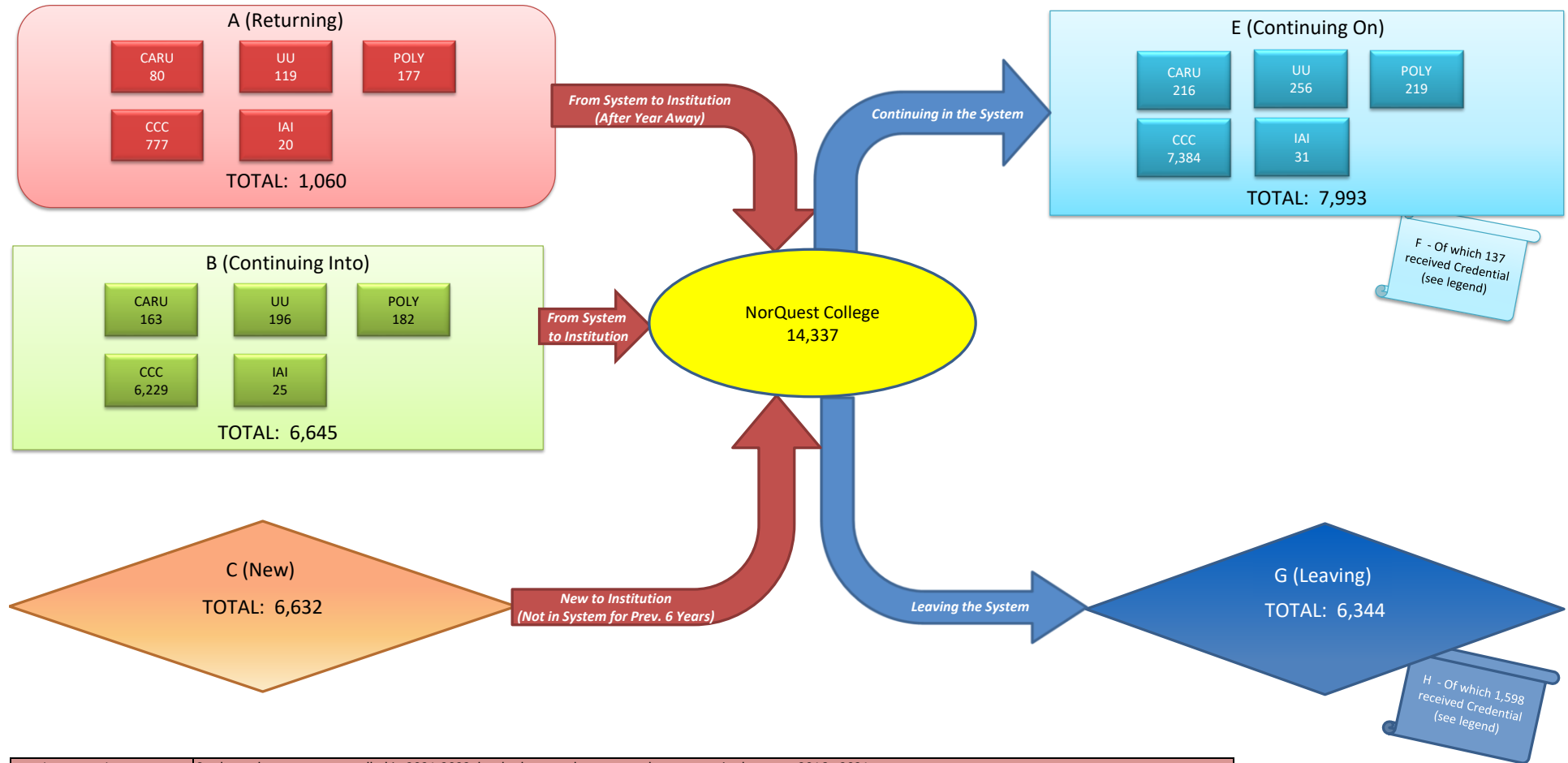


Institution Student Enrolment Flow
