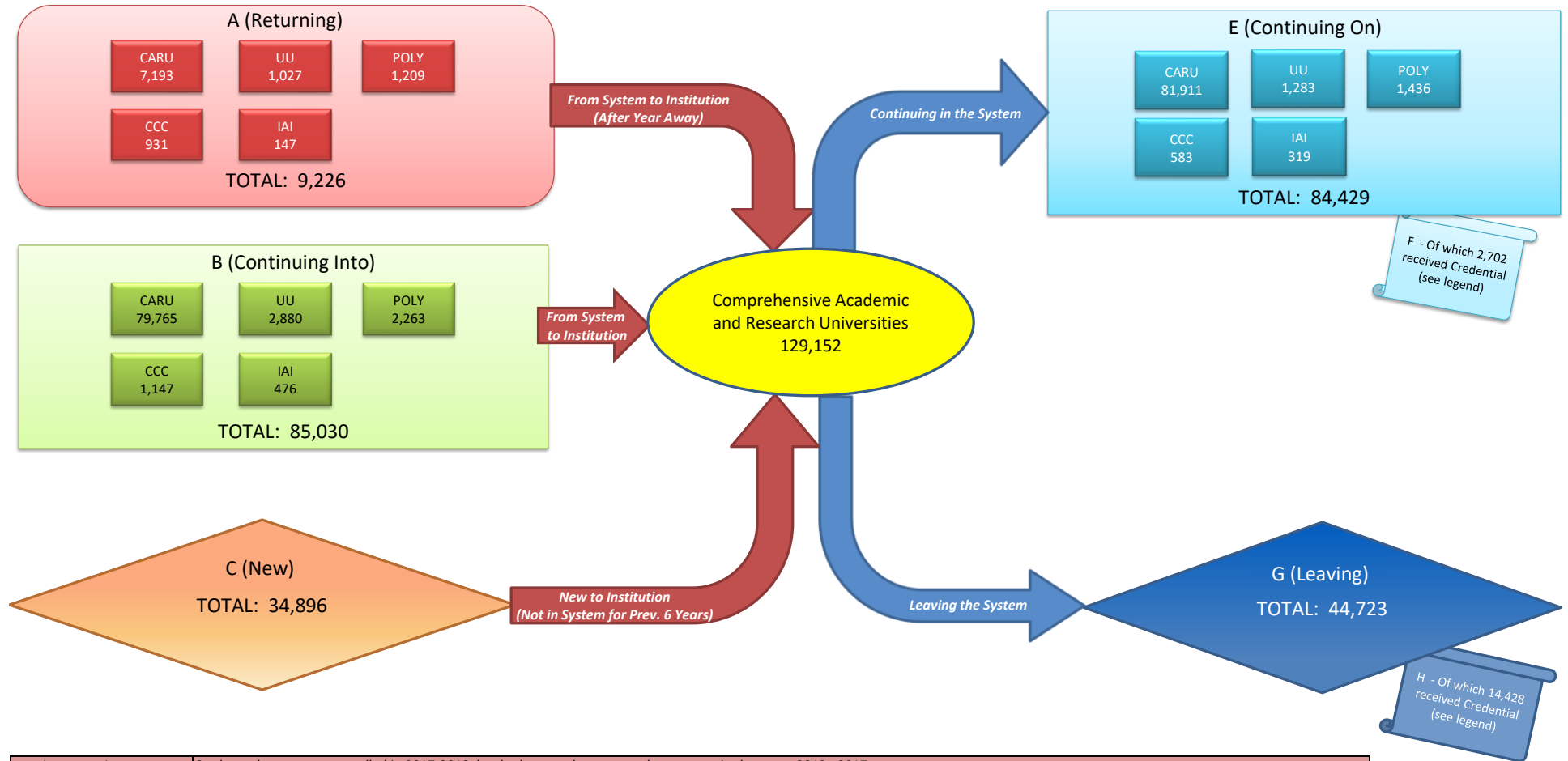


# Sector Student Enrolment Flow

This report provides the student enrolment data for public post-secondary institutions by sector for a given academic year and student movement into, within and out of the sector.

## Comprehensive Academic and Research Universities 2018-2019



A (Returning)	Students that were not enrolled in 2017-2018, but had an enrolment record at some point between 2012 - 2017
B (Continuing into)	Students that were enrolled in the system in 2017-2018
C (New)	Students that had NO enrolment records in the previous 6 years (New to system)
D (Student Cohort)	Students enrolled full-time or part-time in the institution(s) in the cohort year (2018-2019)
E (Continuing On)	Students enrolled in an institution for the following year (2019-2020)
F	Students enrolled in an institution for the following year (2019-2020), and received a credential from Comprehensive Academic and Research Universities in 2018-2019
G (Leaving)	Students NOT enrolled at an institution in the following year (2019-2020)
H	Students NOT enrolled in an institution for the following year (2019-2020), but received a credential from Comprehensive Academic and Research Universities in 2018-2019

- Values listed in the above diagram represent the number of Unique Students at the level you are looking at; therefore, adding up sector numbers in each category may lead to an inflated value.
