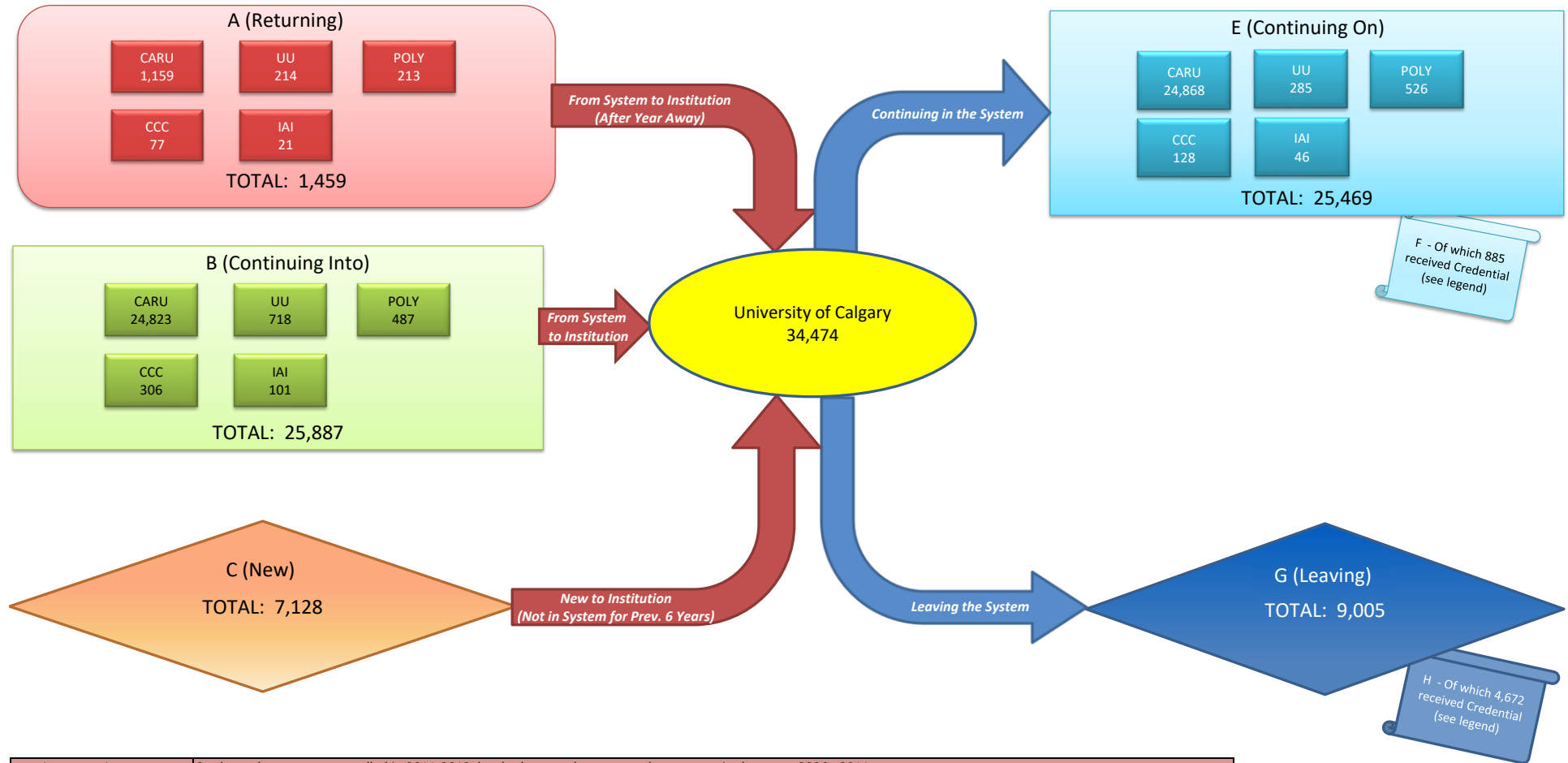


# Institution Student Enrolment Flow
